REVISED 2018 PROGRAMME

This is the revised programme as at 18 March 2018. Further details will shortly appear on the Church website and form part of our Easter newsletter to all group members. Basically, only dates are listed here and these are intended to give you an idea of what is being planned. Obviously, you will need more information.

7 April – **East is East – Bolton Octagon** – currently only one or two seats available. Revised cost will be \pounds 35 (refunds will be made to those already paid in full)

21 May – **Lake District Full day trip** – itinerary to follow which will be centred upon a visit to Bowness and a sail on Lake Windermere

9 June – **Singing in the Rain – Salford Lowry.** (This replaces the visit previously announced to see 'Summer Holiday' at Bolton Octagon). Price being worked out.

21 June – **Ilkley** – a full day trip to take in optional walks, shopping, dining, relaxing and a visit to Ilkley Tennis Tournament. Cost $\pounds 28$ and $\pounds 3$ optional insurance.

11 July –**Agatha Christie's** *Love from a Stranger* at The Lowry Theatre, Salford. Cost £42 and £4 optional insurance. (N.B. We are still seeking tickets for this show and it will be confirmed in the newsletter shortly.)

Mid August – possible Full day trip to Keswick and the North Lakes with optional tickets for the play **Single Spies.** Costing – see 17 October below.

7 and 8 September – **Stratford-upon-Avon** – overnight stay at the Crown Plaza, optional ticket for Romeo and Juliet and return via the national Arboretum at Stoke-on-Trent.

1-5 October – 4 night/5 day visit to **Buxton (Peak District).** Planned excursions each day (to be announced shortly) and optional other activities. Final prices are being calculated.

17 October – Full-day visit to **Keswick** to include, if you wish, a ticket to see **Jeeves and Wooster** at the Theatre by the Lake. Price will be ± 30 with optional theatre ticket purchase. Optional insurance ± 3 or ± 4

Early November – theatre visit to be arranged.(We await the Autumn programmes from the regional theatres.)

21 November – Matilda at the Palace Theatre, Manchester
