
# **District News**

Our next Online Worship is taking place on Sunday 14th December at 6.30pm.



Forty years ago the Faith in the City Report was a landmark example of the Church speaking out on social justice and it seeded thousands of local projects.

Churches Together in Merseyside and Region (CTMR) celebrated this report and its legacy at a wonderful event at the Readers Mansion in Calderstones Park, Liverpool, on Tuesday 25 November.

At the event, the Metro Mayor, Steve Rotherham, was presented with a new Manifesto of Hope declaring a renewed vision of human society and a collective commitment to making this vision a reality for the Liverpool City Region.
