Gas Boiler Parts

The £700K refurbishment project at Lymm has commenced. Part of this work involves replacing the gas boiler (Evomax 80) with an electric air to air heating system and highly efficient and easily managed air source heat pumps. The boiler is 8 years old and might be useful for spares for any church that has a similar boiler.
